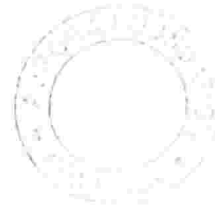

MEMORANDUM OF THE ASSOCIATION

1. NAME OF THE SOCIETY : The name of the Society shall be:-
AURORA FOUNDATION
2. REGISTERED OFFICE : The office of the society shall remain in the National Capital Territory of Delhi and at present it is at the following address:-
RZ-31, A-1BLOCK, DHARAMPURA EXTENTION, NAJAFGARH, NEW DELHI - 110043
3. WORKING AREA : NCT DELHI
4. AIMS AND OBJECTS : The Aims and object for which the society Established are as under:-
1. To undertake research and consultancy services towards achieving the goal of good governance by conducting citizen satisfaction and perception studies on delivery of government services and programs, delivery of public services, examining best practices in different states and countries etc.
 2. To study and document electoral behavior for understanding the needs and priorities of the general public and their evaluation of the performance of public representatives and government to help the present and future government to implement programs and policies in tune with people's expectations.
 3. To establish and develop institution for the physically handicapped and disable or mentally retired girls to provide them education, food, clothing or other help.
 4. To transfer the technology, know how relating to alternative medicines, nature, cure ecology, environment, eco-philosophy the budgets of the government.
 5. To establish, develop, maintain and grant aid in cash and in kind to hospitals, medical, schools, medical colleges, nursing institution, dispensaries, maternity homes, child welfare institution in India for the benefit and use of the general public and daughters/girls.

To run, manage, establishment, charitable, dispensaries, hospitals, research on general diseases, like HIV/AIDA, Hepatitis, T.B. Cancer, Cholera, and Typhoid etc.

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE SOCIETY

1. Name of the Society : Name of the Society shall be:

“AURORA FOUNDATION”.

2. Membership:

The membership of the society is open to any person who has attained the age of majority and fulfils the terms and conditions of the society but the subject to the approval of the Governing body of the society. If the membership is not approved by the Governing Body of the society the reason of refusal shall be communicated to the person/applicant concerned.

3. Admission Fee & Subscription

The admission fee and the subscription shall be as under unless otherwise revised by the Governing Body of the society.

- A) Admission fee: Rs.1100/-at the time of admission
B) Subscription Rs. 250/- Per Annum.

4. Termination:

The Governing Body of the society shall have the powers to expel/terminate a member or/and members, from the membership of the above society, on the following grounds:-

- (i) One his/her death
- (ii) On written resignation.
- (iii) If found to be involved in any anti social activities.
- (iv) If adjudged by any court of law to be a criminal offender.
- (v) If found guilty by means of anti propaganda of the aims and objects of the society.
- (vi) If fails to pay the subscription of contribution for the three months.
- (vii) If has not attended three consecutive meetings.
- (viii) If disregard Rules & Regulations or disobey the decision of the Governing Body.

The decision of the Governing Body regarding the termination from the membership of the society shall be communicated to the member concerned.

5. General Body Defined:

All the members of the society will constitute the General Body of the Society.

6. General Body:

- a) Notice: Minimum 10 days notice shall be given to the members, before the date of General Body meetings, enclosing agenda specifying date, time, place and issues to be discussed.
- b) Meeting: General Body meeting shall be held once in every year regularly.
- c) Quorum: The Quorum of General Body meeting shall be 2/3rd (Two Third) of the total strength of the General Body Members of the Society.

7. Rights & Privileges of Members:

All and every members of the Society:-

- a) Shall be entitled to participate in meetings, cultural/educational functions and other lawful gathering, called/arranged by the Society.
- b) Have right to collect the Identity card after depositing the required/prescribed (fixed by the Governing Body of the Society from time to time).

8. Duties of the Members:-

All and every members of Society shall:-

- a) Elect the Governing Body of the Society.
- b) Attend the General Body meeting regularly.
- c) Give the necessary information to the society, pertaining to any matter, which is necessary to be known by the society.
- d) Not indulge in activities, which are prejudicial to the aims and objects and/or the Rules & Regulations of the Society.

9. Governing Body:

- a) Strength: The Strength of Governing Body (including office bearers and executive member) shall not be less than 7 and not more than 21.
- b) Terms: Terms of every governing body shall be Five Years. The present governing body shall be taking care of the society the new election takes place.
- c) Notice: Minimum 7 days notice shall be required for every Governing Body meeting of the society but urgent governing Body meeting can be called by 24 hours notice.
- d) Quorum: Quorum of every governing Body meeting shall be 2/3rd (Two Third) of the total strength of the governing body (including office bearers and executive members).
- e) Meeting: Governing body meeting shall be held once in three months regularly (or as and when the Governing Body of the society may decide from time to time).
- f) Urgent Meeting: The urgent Governing Body may be called by the 24 hours notice.

10. Functions & Powers of Governing Body:

- a) Governing Body shall be responsible for the management and administration of all affairs of the society, and is also authorized to appoint any office bearers/executive members to look after any particular activities.
- b) All the decisions shall be taken by the majority votes.
- c) The Governing Body shall have the powers, as are the of the society and in these Rules & Regulations. The Governing Body shall have also the following powers.
- d) To prepare plans, projects and programs.
- e) To appoint Election officer and his/her powers.

11. Composition of the Governing Body:

The Composition of the Governing Body shall be as under:-

A)	PRESIDENT	ONE
B)	VICE PRESIDENT	ONE
C)	SECRETARY	ONE
D)	TREASURER	ONE
E)	EXECUTIVE MEMBERS	TWO to 16

12. Powers and Duties of Officer Bearers:

President:

- a) President shall preside over all the meetings of the Society.
- b) At the time of voting on any matter/subject (except election), if the total votes of the groups of members happen to equal in number, the President has the power to cast an extra vote to decide the matter/subject.
- c) President shall have the power to allow inclusion of any subject/matter in the agenda for the discussion in the course of proceedings/meetings.
- d) President will sign all the papers/letters, on behalf of the society, to conduct its correspondence.

Vice President:

The Vice President of the society shall enjoy all the powers of the President in his/her absence.

General Secretary:

- a) Gen. Secretary will summon and attend the meetings of the Governing Body and General Body.
- b) General Secretary will prepare the Membership Register as well as the Proceedings Register to record the minutes of the proceedings of the Governing Body Meetings and the General Body meetings and have them duly signed by the members who attend the meetings.

Secretary:

The Secretary of the society shall enjoy all the powers of the Gen. Secretary in his/her absence.

- a) All funds of society shall remain the care and management of Treasurer.
- b) Treasurer shall maintain the accounts of all money, which is received and/or paid by him/her on behalf of the society.
- c) * Treasurer shall make disbursement in accordance with the direction of Governing Body.

13. Re-Admission:

In case, any member of the society is expelled the Governing Body on the reason of Non payment of the subscription, he can be re-admitted, provided the member concerned pays all up to date dues with the permission of the Governing Body. *

14. Appeals:

All the appeals shall be preferred to the General Body of the society and the decision of the General Body shall be final.

15. Filling up of casual vacancies:

Any casual vacancy amongst the Governing Body, shall be filled by the resolution passed the Governing body such appointment(s) shall be confirmed by the General Body in its coming General Body Meeting.

16. Election:

General Body in its Annual meeting will elect in President and all the office bearers and also the Executive Members of the Governing Body, after every 5 Years by secret ballot papers or by show of hands as the Election office may decide. The newly elected governing body list should be attested by three outgoing office bearers and it will be filed with registrar of the societies, Delhi.

17. Sources of Income:

All the income of the society shall be utilized only for the promotion and up liftment of the aims and objects of the society. Sources of income of the society are as under:-

- a) Admission Fee & Subscription from the members of the Society.
- b) Donations and special contributions.

18. Financial Year:

Financial year of society shall start from 1st April to 31st March every year.

19. Audit:

The accounts of society shall be audited by the qualified auditor (Chartered Accountant) every year.

20. Management of funds & Accounts operation:

- a) The Funds of the Association shall be kept in the name of the Association in any scheduled bank, in Delhi, as may be decided by the Executive Council. President, and Treasurer shall be signatory. The 2/3rd majority of the General Council shall approve all major expenditure. Bank Accounts shall be operated by joint signatures of Treasurer and President.
- b) The funds of the society shall be invested and kept invested only in such properties securities and or investment which are permissible under section 11(5) and /or other provisions of the Income Tax Act, 1961 for the time being in force and the Governing Body is authorized to alter, vary or transfer such investments for time to time as fit it may in its discretion think if and proper permissible under the Income Tax Act, 1961 for a charitable society.

21. Annual list of governing body:

Once in every year a list of the officer-bearers and the Executive members (of the Governing Body) shall be filled in the office of the Registrar of society, Delhi. As it is required under section 4 of "Societies Registration Act, of 1860".

22. Dissolution:

If the society needs to be dissolved, it shall be dissolved as per-provisions laid down under the sec.31 &14 "Societies Registration Act, of 1860" as applicable National Capital Territory of Delhi.

23. Legal Proceeding:

Society may use and/or be used in the name of President as per provisions laid down under sec. 6 The "Societies Registration Act, of 1860" as applicable to National Capital Territory of Delhi.

24. Amendment:

Any amendment, in Memorandum Rules and Regulations will be carried out in accordance with section 12 & 12A of the "Societies Registration Act, of 1860", as applicable to National Capital Territory of Delhi.

25. Application of The Act:

All the provisions under all the section of the "Societies Registration Act, of 1860", as applicable to National Capital Territory of Delhi, shall be applicable to this society.

26. Essential Certificate:
